**Fire Protection Assessment Fee Residential Hardship Exemption**

**MIRAMAR-** It is that time of year again to file for the Fire Protection Assessment Fee Residential Hardship Exemption. Effective 2004, all residential units were assessed a Fire Protection Assessment Fee. You may be eligible for an exemption from this fee if you meet certain criteria and submit an application with all of the required documentation.

Households where the homeowner resides and meet income criteria are eligible for the Residential Hardship Exemption. In addition, seniors over the age of 65 who receive the additional Senior Exemption from the Broward County Property Appraiser are also eligible.

May 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 marks the beginning of the filing season for the Hardship Exemption and all applications must be submitted, either by drop-off or mailing no later than July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2010. Applications can be picked up and dropped off at the City of Miramar Multi-Service Complex located at 6700 Miramar Parkway, Monday thru Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
