Free Community-wide Program Will Provide Answers**

MIRAMAR- Seniors citizens and their families are invited to **Roadmap for Aging: A Day to Point the Way, on Thursday, May 27** at the City of Miramar Multi Service Complex, located at 6700 Miramar Parkway. The free program is sponsored by three South Florida community agencies: the Broward Coalition on Aging, the Palm Beach Partnership for Aging, and Jewish Community Services of South Florida.

A first-of-its-type event, **Roadmap for Aging** will be conducted at a number of senior and community centers in Broward County, including the Miramar Multi-Service Complex.
